Fourth Casey Gerry partner elected to prestigious trial lawyer association

Thomas Luneau, a partner at Casey Gerry Schenk Francavilla Blatt & Penfield LLP, was elected to the American Board of Trial Advocates (ABOTA), a national association of the nation's leading judges and trial lawyers.

Membership to ABOTA, which is committed to the preservation and promotion of the civil jury trial, is by invitation only.

"We are now the only plaintiffs firm San Diego to have four partners who are members of ABOTA," said Casey Gerry managing partner David S. Casey Jr.

Other firm partners who are members include Casey, Frederick Schenk and Robert Francavilla.

Earning numerous multi-million-dollar verdicts and settlements, Luneau focuses his practice primarily on serious personal injury and premises and products liability. His cases involve defective industrial drilling machinery, motorcycle lane splitting injuries, concussion injuries, and wrongful death.

Luneau started his career as state-licensed private investigator, joining Casey Gerry in 1982 as a staff investigator. He is putting his investigative training to work, focusing on serious injuries caused by commercial truck collisions -- difficult cases that involve the interplay between state and federal laws and regulations and complex fact patterns.
